Item I: Actions Taken

Actions taken was reported as follows.

January-March 2025:

1. Dr. A. Rajmani Singha, Director, IQAC, Manipur University, Manipur visited the IQAC Office of the University on January 15, 2025. A meeting of the IQAC Team was also scheduled to discuss IQAC concerns with him.
2. The 53rd University Annual Report for session 2022-23 was presented at the University Senate which was held on January 20, 2025 and the same was approved.
3. NAAC-AQAR for the academic year 2023-24 was submitted online on NAAC portal on January 27, 2025 and the same have been approved successfully by NAAC. The said report was also approved in the University Syndicate held on February 05, 2025.
4. Common Suggestions from GNDU to UGC Feedback on UGC's Document for Evaluating HEIs Based on NEP 2020 Implementation was submitted to UGC on February 03, 2025.

5. Data was submitted on AISHE Portal, Ministry of Education, Government of India for session 2023-24 on February 14, 2025.
6. The requisite data of that facilitated & assisted for the Affiliated, University & Constituents Colleges regarding AISHE Portal, Ministry of Education, Government of India, was uploaded on AISHE Portal for session 2023-24, on February 28, 2025.
7. GNDU participated in "THE WEEK: Best University Survey 2025" and the data for session 2024-25 was submitted on March 13, 2025 by IQAC.

April-June 2025:

1. Formation of IQAC committee for the session 2025-26.
2. GNDU participated in "India Today- MDRA Best Universities Ranking 2025", IQAC compiled the data for online portal of MDRA (PG students) for session 2023-24 and submitted the same on April 04, 2025.

6. "Raj Ankrha Sar 2024-25", the data of students in prescribed proforma for session 2024-25 was submitted on May 28, 2025 to Deputy District Education Officer, Amritsar (Government of Punjab).
7. Director IQAC was appointed as **Nodal Officer** for Professor of Practice POP portal, NEP-SAARTHI Portal, Ph.D. Excellence Citation and IQAC office is regularly working upon it.
8. UTSAH Portal was completed on June 25, 2025. All information regarding Multidisciplinary and Holistic Education; Digital Empowerment and Online Education; Skill Development and Employability; Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurship; Capacity Building of Teachers for Quality Education; Governance and Autonomy; Accreditation and Excellence; Equitable and Inclusive Education; Promotion of Indian Languages and Indian Knowledge System; Internationalization of Education was uploaded.
9. The 54th University Annual Report 2023-2024 has been compiled.
10. The University Calendar Volume IV, IQAC regulation/guidelines has been updated as per the guidelines of the NAAC.

April-June 2025





4. Attended 2nd All India IQAC Workshop 2025, organized by IQAC, Uttaranchal University, in hybrid mode from June 27-28, 2025.



Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is involved in the following activities at present.


1. Data Collection for the University Annual Report 2024-25
